

## Berks Street Art Festival 2023 Food Vendor Agreement

### **By registering, you certify you are agreeing to the following:**

1. All food vendors, including food trucks, must register at the Camel Caravan bus before proceeding to your assigned vendor spot. Registration and vendor setup is 8 am-8:30 am on the morning of the event.
2. Food trucks must be in their assigned spot by 9:00 am.
3. Non-truck food vendors: you may bring your vehicle to your vendor spot to unload, etc. but you must have the vehicle off the Festival lot by 9:30 am. Parking is available behind the RMCT building
4. For safety of our attendees, roads around the Festival will be closed once the event starts. Please, do not leave your spot until after the event ends at 2:00 pm.
5. Vendors may have tables, chairs, tents, exhibits, etc. of any kind as long as they fit within the assigned space size, and they do not interfere with other vendors or the event itself. Sorry, electric service is not available.
6. No smoking or alcohol allowed, including anywhere on the Festival grounds.
7. Only the organization responsible for this exhibitor contract may occupy the space. Your space must represent only the business that is registered with The Camel Project.
8. Please note: all CDC Covid-19 restrictions as of the event date will be followed for all attendees, including participants, spectators, and vendors.
9. You must submit a copy of your food vendor license, if required by law\*, to The Camel Project by May 1, 2021. Please send copies of your food vendor license to: [saf2023@thecamelproject.org](mailto:saf2023@thecamelproject.org).
